

Jonava Senamiestis Gymnasium

Jonava Senamiestis Gymnasium was established on June 11, 1998 by Regulation No 85 of Jonava District Municipality Council on the basis of Secondary School Number 4, which was founded on September 15, 1974. The first class graduated in 1976. According to Jonava District Board Regulation No 117 of August 3, 1994, the school was renamed Jonava Senamiestis Secondary School on September 1, 1994. The same year two gymnasium classes started and successfully graduated in 1998.

Students have been graduating from the school for 41 years, including 18 years under the gymnasium status. Class 2018 will be the 20th of the gymnasium graduates.

The cooperation of parents, their children and teachers is highly valued by the community, old traditions are maintained and new ones are introduced, students' individuality and creativity as well as their cooperation with social partners are developed. Since 1974, the continuity of the school history and culture has been fostered as one of the top priorities.

The Main Activities

Jonava Senamiestis Gymnasium is an upper-secondary school which provides general education.

Senamiestis Gymnasium offers:

- a two - year course of lower - secondary (basic) education (for students aged 15-16);
- a two - year course of upper - secondary education (for students aged 17-19);
- non-formal education (activities after lessons).

Jonava Senamiestis Gymnasium is a modern, competitive school constantly learning and open to change that develops the abilities and inclinations of every student and shapes a responsible person with a unique life strategy and the ability to adjust to a changing world and cherish both national and universal human values.

Learning

Besides the basic subjects, students can select some optional subjects or modules. The curricula of different subjects provide integrated, individualized and differentiated education process.

Students cover the curriculum of secondary education according to their individual education plans. These plans can differ in subjects, their courses and modules. Students can choose from two courses of the

same subject: basic (B) and extended (A). Foreign language courses B2, B1 and A1/A2, suggested by the European Council, are chosen by students according to their level of achievement.

Learning Environment

Senamiestis Gymnasium is a modern school with well-equipped science labs, a preparatory room for teachers, a rich modernized library, two reading rooms (one of them online). All classrooms are equipped with up-to-date teaching materials, computers and multimedia. There is an assembly hall and sports facilities, renewed sports courts, a gym and other facilities and equipment necessary for training.
